

Travel and Publication Support Policy for PPI Ph.D. Students

To promote research excellence and strengthen the visibility of PPI graduate research programs, this policy outlines support available to PPI Ph.D. students for eligible travel or publication expenses. Each Ph.D. advisor may receive support for one student per academic year under this policy. Awards will range from \$1,000 to \$2,500, based on the quality of the accepted paper and the extent of unmet financial need. Funds may be used for travel to present at top-tier conferences or to cover publication fees for high-impact journals.

PPI Ph.D. students are eligible for support if their request meets either of the following criteria:

- **Conference Travel:** The student is presenting a peer-reviewed full paper at a top-tier conference with an acceptance rate below **30%**.
- **Journal Publication Fee:** The article has been accepted by a peer-reviewed journal with an impact factor of **8.0 or higher** or classified as **Q1** in the relevant discipline.

Required Documentation:

- **Conferences:** Official acceptance notification and documentation of the conference acceptance rate.
- **Journals:** Acceptance notice and evidence of the journal's impact factor or Q1 classification, such as documentation from Clarivate JCR or Scopus.
