2014-15 GUIDELINES LOWER OHIO VALLEY CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY FUND SCHOLARSHIP (LOVCIF)

For over thirty years, the Lower Ohio Valley Construction Fund (LOVCIF) has supported the advancement of the construction industry in the lower Ohio River Valley Region.

LOVCIF Scholarships are based on the following criteria:

- 1. All LOVCIF Scholarships will be awarded to students who are majoring in a related field of the construction industry, either management or labor, excluding apprenticeship programs for specific employers in the construction industry. However, see special consideration below in point 5 as that also qualifies a student to apply.
- 2. LOVCIF Scholarship recipients must be United States citizens who graduated from a high school within a one hundred mile radius of Evansville, IN.
- 3. Eligible first-time recipients must be at least sophomore students in 2014-15 majoring in a construction related field such as management in the School of Business or Internet Technology. However, see special consideration in point 5 below as that also enables students to apply for the scholarship.
- 4. Consideration will be given for both financial need and scholastic ability.
- 5. Special consideration will be given to applicants who can demonstrate that one of their parents or grandparents works or has worked at one of the following companies in either a management position or as a union laborer. APPLY IF YOU MEET THIS CRITERION.
