

NAVAL COURSE CLASSES



- Naval Science Courses (3 credits)
 - Intro to Naval Science
 - Naval Weapons Systems
 - Naval History
 - Leadership, Ethics, and Management
 - Navigation I & II
 - Naval Operations

- Every semester NS 202 (2 credits)
 - Lab 2 hrs/wk
 - PT 3 hrs/wk





MIDSHIPMAN SUMMER TRAINING



- 3/C Summer Cruise (Between freshman/sophomore year)
 - Career Orientation and Training for Midshipmen (CORTRAMID)
 - Submarine, Aviation, Surface and Marine Training (4 weeks)
- 2/C Summer Cruise (Between sophomore/junior year)
 - Atlantic/Pacific Training of Midshipmen (LANTRAMID/PACTRAMID)
 - Navy Sea Trials (2 week, intensive training and Pass/Fail evaluation)
 - USMC MAGTF cruise (2-3 weeks, Marine professional training)
- 1/C Summer Cruise (Between junior/senior year)
 - Summer Training Assignments
 - Navy Submarine, Aviation, Surface or Special Warfare (4 weeks–Officer Cruise)
 - USMC Officer Candidate School (6 weeks)
 - Foreign Exchange Training of Midshipmen (FOREXTRAMID)
 - Japanese Maritime Self-defense Force (JMSDF) Exchanges







NAVAL ROTC SCHOLARSHIPS



- Scholarships pay fee/tuition <or>
 <or>
 Room and Board
 - Book allowance \$750/year
 - Monthly stipend \$250-\$400/month
- High School Seniors National Board
 - Mainly technical degrees (engineering, computer science, chemistry, etc.)
 - College students < 30 semester hours are eligible
 - Nurse/Navy/Marine options
- Scholarships for college students (30 < semester hours < 90)
 - 2 and 3 year scholarships available high success rate at Purdue





POST GRADUATION SERVICE



- Earn commission as an Ensign (USN) or 2nd Lieutenant (USMC)
- 5 Year Commitment
 - Submarine Warfare
 - Surface Warfare
 - Marines
 - Naval Special Warfare (NSW)
 - Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD)
- 8 Year Commitment
 - Naval Flight Officer (NFO)
- 10 Year Commitment
 - Naval Aviator









NROTC SUMMARY



- 4-year program

- Monthly stipend and semester book stipend
- DO NOT need scholarship to join
- Wide range of opportunities
- Guaranteed job right out of college
