Summer Financial Aid

The Summer 2015 Aid Application is now available on myPurdue under the "Financial" tab. You must have a 2014-2015 FASFA on file as well. Students must take at minimum 6 credit hours during summer sessions in order to be eligible for financial aid.

In addition, IUPUC tuition rates are discounted 25% for Summer 2015, providing a great opportunity for PCOT students to take courses at a reduced cost. If you have any questions or concerns, feel free to contact Anji, Whitney, or Andrew for assistance.

Summer and Fall Registration

Summer and fall schedule of courses are now available online. Summer and fall advising and registration for currently enrolled students begins on March 25th and ends on April 30th.

Important financial aid information that currently enrolled students should keep in mind at this time includes:

Students interested in taking summer classes will need to submit the Summer Aid Application in order to be considered for financial aid. This is available on the Financial Tab in myPurdue. Along with the summer application, students will need to have a 2014-15 FAFSA on file and also have all requirements on myPurdue completed.

All students attending a Technology Statewide campus (this includes Columbus) will be required to submit a PLANSE document which will be listed on myPurdue. This requirement, along with any other additional requests for information, must be completed before students can be awarded financial aid.

Continuing students who have all requirements complete will receive their financial aid award in mid-June.
