English Placement Survey

All plans of study at Purdue Polytechnic Columbus require students to take English Composition. Purdue Columbus has two English courses available for students. ENG W131 and ENG W131 SI (with Supplement Instruction). ENG W131 SI offers additional support to help students meet the competencies required to be successful at Purdue. ENG W131 SI is a great option for students who would say that reading and writing aren't one of their top strengths.

The English Placement Survey is a tool that helps students identify which of the two English courses would be right for them. Each student who does not have credit for a college-level English composition class is required to complete the survey.

Purdue Polytechnic Columbus students will utilize the English Guided Self-Placement survey offered via IUPUI. Follow the steps below to complete the survey. Students must email a copy of their completed survey and course suggestion prior to STAR orientation day.

Step 1: Go to http://english.uc.iupui.edu/

- Step 3: Login with your IUPUC Career Account Information

 - * You may use the Snipping Tool or Screenshot your results and simply copy/paste into the body of an email.
 - * Be sure to include your name and PUID number with your results.
