Plan of Study Overview

Purdue Online - Polytechnic Institute's online program is 100% online. Instructors provide the material, lectures, tests and assignments that can be accessed at any time. Your lectures are available on Purdue's Learning Management System, **Brightspace**. The lectures are not time restricted, meaning you will not need to be logged in to preview your course material at any specific time. All of your course activities, assignments, and exams must be completed by their respective due dates. You will need to view course lectures regularly to keep current. The length of our courses are offered in 16-week modules each fall and spring, and 12-week modules during the summer.

The curriculum for the MS is taught by internationally recognized faculty, which engages in original research based on your specific scholarly interests, and will utilize your findings to develop new approaches. You can complete your degree in just 22 months - 5 years while balancing your professional and personal commitments. The curriculum will help expand your knowledge to understand how policies and law affect technology innovation and influence global technology and organizational leadership.
