

Credit for PLTW Coursework in the Purdue Polytechnic

Students who enroll in majors in the following departments in the Purdue Polytechnic* may receive 3 to 12 hours of credit for PLTW coursework:

- Construction Management Technology
- Engineering Technology
- Technology Leadership & Innovation

In order to receive credit, the following criteria must be met:

- The student must be enrolled in one of the programs of study in the departments listed above
- The high school must be a PLTW school
- Student must earn a grade of “B” or better in all portions of the course

The PLTW courses accepted for credit vary by program; not all courses apply to a particular program. Contact your academic advisor for details on which courses apply to your program of study.

Noted below are the approved PLTW courses and their Purdue University course equivalent:
