DETAILED CRAFTSMANSHIP

The unique design of this ring will instantly identify you as a Purdue University ROTC officer. On top of the signet styled ring sits Purdue's Griffin, symbolizing both the mission of the University; education, research, and service; and the traditional military meaning of strength, courage, and leadership. One side features the crest of your branch and the year of your commissioning. On the other, an image of the Purdue Memorial Union is featured. At the close of World War I, Purdue looked at the record of her sons and daughters in the service and in many minds there arose the thought that the union should stand as a permanent memorial to those 4,013 who had served and those 67 who had died for their country.

Currently the Union stands as a permanent memorial to the Purdue men and women of all conflicts who served and continue to serve in defense of their country, protecting the very freedoms that we enjoy today.

For each branch of service, a men's or women's style of ring can be ordered. Rings are available in your choice of 10K, 14K or 18K solid yellow gold in a natural or antiqued finish or a combat ring made from a fine jeweler's stainless steel alloy with a silver toned look that offers value, strength and durability.
