Technology, Innovation, and Culture in Germany (MFET 49900) is a three-credit course based in western and southern Germany in May 2026. This course is a two-week exploration of innovation in industry and technology, including visits to partner universities that offer extended study abroad opportunities. In this experience, you will explore cultural and historical sites, interact with your German counterparts, and get private tours of some of the world's most innovative production facilities employing Industry 4.0 technology (BMW, Merck, Mercedes-Benz, Audi, Fendt, Faber-Castell, and others).

The planned itinerary includes stops in Frankfurt, Mainz, Darmstadt, Stuttgart, Reutlingen, Nuremberg, Füssen, Garmisch-Partenkirchen, and Munich, with the opportunity to independently visit additional locations.

Eligible for Purdue Moves scholarships. The program fee (estimated at \$4000) covers lodging, ground transportation, tickets, and most meals. The cost does not cover airfare to or from Germany. We are limited to 14 participants due to the unique nature of this program, so apply today.
